Your primary focus is to plan and facilitate the programming during each camp session. You will support our Summer Staff (made up of cabin counsellors and our LIT coordinator), our Facility Staff, LIT's and volunteers. Further, you will need to be prepared to lead your hired area of expertise and help train other staff, LIT's and volunteers on the various aspects of your role. Your role may require performing other tasks as assigned by the Program Director and Camp Director when needed, including but not limited to: cabin counselling, cleaning duties, and leading activities not designated as a part of your role. The goal is to work together as a team to serve the campers, God and one another!

Specific Responsibilities

5. This role may require working with our volunteer medic and/or Program Director to keep track of medications.
